# **POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES & RECOMMEDATIONS**

Usable space for your poster is 44" high and 92" wide. Plan to mount your materials during the 30 minutes preceding the poster presentation session during which your poster is to be visible. You may need pushpins, tape, or other adhesives to adhere your work to the chosen vertical surface, so please come prepared. As principle author, you are required to be present at your poster display during the last ½ hour of the session to answer questions from attendees. Authors may distribute copies of their abstract or related materials to their audience. Plan to remove your poster immediately following the end of your session. Posters not removed and as directed following the session will be considered abandoned and discarded.

### **Helpful Hints**

- Organize your poster topics in a logical and appropriate manner.
- Overly detailed descriptions detract from your main point/s and other aspects of your presentation.
- Poster text should be of a font size and type that can be read at a distance of at least 3 feet away.
- Borders, background, and display organization are at your discretion, but should be placed to enhance the material presented.
- Graphs or photographic images should have strong contrasts and clear labeling for concise communication.
- Graphic material should be appropriately coordinated with text.
